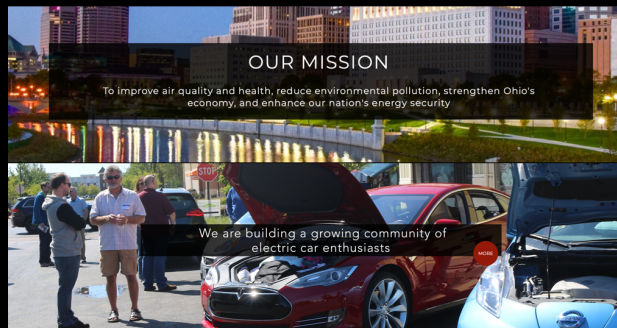
- Our mission is to educate young people on the science of climate change and empower them to take action.

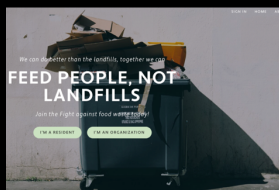
- Since 2007 our staff, farmers, and volunteers have delivered more than 140,000 share baskets to our members.
- We fight malnutrition in “food desert” neighborhoods where residents have few options to meet their dietary needs.
- City Fresh pays 81¢ of every shareholder dollar directly to farmers in the alliance.

- We farm. We have turned an empty and forgotten piece of land in Cleveland's Kinsman Neighborhood into an urban farm where we produce healthy food.
- So far, we have built 2 green houses, 4 hoop houses, and a 40,000 Sqft Aquaponics fishery for Tilapia.
- We compost. Discards from the Cleveland Food Bank, coffee grounds and leftover hops from coffee shops and breweries contribute. The Rust Belt Riders transport much of those discards to us.

- For residential, we have two programs. One is a drop-off program, and the other is a food scrap pick-up service.

- We build power through collective ownership.
- We consult with Central / Kinsman residents who are investigating whether a food co-op could help meet the needs of their neighbors.
- In the east side neighborhood of Hough, we are working with neighbors to build the city's first community solar garden.
- In Lakewood, we are incubating a resident-owned Lakewood Community Solar Cooperative.
